Wherever possible, rehabilitated birds and animals are returned to the wild and those that are not so fortunate due to the nature and extent of their injuries are used to educate the many people who visit us each year.

The Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre at Moholoholo contributes to the conservation of endangered species and the rehabilitation of injured & poisoned wildlife.

Moholoholo also facilitates a number of successful breeding programs.

Lion, Leopard, Serval, Lynx, Honey Badger, Eagles, Vultures, Wild Dogs.

A visit to the centre will stimulate awareness and understanding of the plight which our wildlife faces today.
