



Junior Wildlife Education

OVERVIEW

Moholoholo is proud of the contribution it makes to nature conservation by educating today's youth in a fun and engaging environment. We believe it is our duty to instil environmental awareness from a young age in order to protect our natural heritage.

Nestled at the foot of the spectacular Northern Drakensberg Mountain Range in Limpopo Province, Moholoholo lies within the scenic Lowveld Acacia Woodland. It has become a preferred destination for nature enthusiasts, school groups, and wildlife interest organisations alike. Moholoholo is home to a wide variety of animals and birds, and learners may have the opportunity to encounter Rhino, Buffalo, Hippo, and even Leopard – to name just a few.

At Moholoholo, we offer tailor-made Junior Wildlife Packages for school groups, giving learners the chance to participate in a wide range of ecological and conservation activities. One of the highlights of their stay is the unforgettable "sleep-out" under the beautiful African sky. As part of our educational programme, groups also visit our world-renowned Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre for injured and endangered animals – an experience that leaves lasting memories and a deeper appreciation for nature.



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ACCOMMODATION

Students are accommodated in comfortable, neat thatched double chalets. Each chalet can accommodate up to 12 students and is equipped with its own toilet, basin, and two showers.

All bedding is provided, including blankets, a pillow, and sheets. Please bring your own towels. Students must also bring their own sleeping bags for the “sleep-out” activity.

Teachers are accommodated in comfortable, two-bedded thatched chalets, each with its own veranda, fridge, and en-suite bathroom. All bedding and towels are supplied. Teachers are also required to bring their own sleeping bags for the “sleep-out”.



FACILITIES

The camp features an outdoor boma and braai area, as well as a modern, open-plan thatched area where breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served. This area also serves as the venue for all lectures and group discussions.

A swimming pool is available on the premises and may be used at own risk. A key will be handed to the teachers, who will be responsible for supervising their students.



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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- There is no telephone at the camp; however, cellular reception is good.
- A doctor is located nearby, should medical assistance be required. Please inform us in advance of any allergies or medical conditions that we should be aware of.
- We also recommend that you consult your doctor regarding malaria prevention medication before your visit.

Moholoholo is located approximately 70 kilometres from the Kruger National Park's Orpen Gate and is the perfect base from which to explore the beautiful Lowveld region of South Africa.
